



P.E and Sports Funding

As you will be aware, the Government give funding to schools for P.E and Sport. This amount is a lump sum of £8,000 with an additional sum of £5 per pupil.

We try to ensure that the money is spent wisely and that all our children at Busill Jones Primary School benefit from the additional funding. This is how we spent our sports funding in 2013/14

- We employed Sports Plus to provide lunchtime and afterschool sports provision which builds confidence and self esteem.
- We employed Sports Plus to provide professional development opportunities including cover to release teachers.
- We trained two members of staff as qualified swimming coaches for KS1 & KS2 pupils.
- We provided transport for two classes to attend swimming instruction at another local school.
- We hired a qualified swimming instructor to teach swimming in KS2 and the hire of the pools used.

- To continue to hire a qualified swimming instructor to teach swimming in KS2 and the hire of the pools used.
- To fund a swimming instructor for KS1 pupils.
- To fund a teaching assistant to provide a sports after school club for KS2 pupils.
- To provide places for pupils in after school clubs, including any dance and fitness classes on site.

Sports funding 2017/18- £21,000

We will use our funding to do the following:

- To continue to employ 2 Sports Plus Coaches to provide an active lunchtime break which builds confidence and self-esteem.
- To continue to hire a qualified swimming instructor to teach swimming in KS2 and the hire of the pool used.
- To fund a teaching assistant to provide a sports after school club for KS2 pupils.
- To support pupils to attend out of school sport tournaments.

The sports funding has enabled the children of Busill Jones Primary School to take part and enjoy a variety of sporting activities. We encourage our children to choose a healthy lifestyle. Our sports clubs are well attended. We are very proud of all our pupils' sporting achievements at Busill Jones.
